

For the last 2 years, BHFN community members and Chief & Council have identified that one of the Land & Resources Department priorities is to prepare a Community Land Use Plan for the BHFN reserves. Our funding proposal to prepare the plan was approved by INAC and we started engaging the community in November 2016 in the planning process.

A Community Land Use Plan sets out the vision, intent and policies for managing lands and resources on the reserve lands. The process of preparing a Community Land Use Plan will help clarify any land issues, challenges and opportunities.

The Plan will put forward goals, objectives and strategies for environmental protection, economic development, and effective land management, and designate lands to which these policies will apply.
